IV DOCTORAL FORUM JAN KOCHANOWSKI UNIVERSITY KIELCE

17th – 19th November 2020

We are delighted to welcome you to the IV Doctoral Forum under the auspices of JM Rector of the Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce which will be held as a hybrid conference (on the premises and remotely) on 17th - 19th November 2020. The conference will be held at the Department of Exact and Natural Sciences, Jan Kochanowski University, 7 Uniwersytecka Street, Kielce.

We invite doctoral students from Jan Kochanowski University and doctoral students from other universities to deliver oral presentations. Bachelor's and master's students from Jan Kochanowski University and from other universities are also invited to prepare poster presentations.

The IV Doctoral Forum serves the exchange of thoughts, experiences, and ideas as part of interdisciplinary research. The conference is also a report session on the progress of doctoral dissertations. Participation in the Doctoral Forum is free of charge and:

- 1) obligatory for doctoral students who have not submitted their doctoral dissertation,
- 2) optional for doctoral students who have submitted their doctoral dissertation and want to present the results of their research.

The scientific program will cover the themes of the following sections:

- 1. Section of Human Sciences,
- 2. Section of Natural Sciences,
- 3. Section of Social Sciences and Art,
- 4. Section of Medical and Health Sciences.

During the conference, doctoral students should present their progress in the realization of their doctoral dissertations or their research results concerning individual scientific interests. Doctoral students present their research in the oral presentation.

ORAL PRESENTATION

The oral presentation should be prepared in PDF file. The presentation should be 10 minutes long and contain:

- 1. work concept/initial research (applies to participants of the 1st year of the Doctoral School),
- 2. progress of scientific research in the past academic year (applies to participants of the II, III, IV year of the doctoral school and participants of doctoral studies).

Oral presentations and poster presentations should be presented in English in the Section of Natural Sciences. The presentations in the Section of Medical and Health Sciences, Section of Human Sciences and Section of Social Sciences and Art can be presented both in English or Polish, but a presentation in English is recommended.

PRODOMUS AWARD

All the presentations of the doctoral students from the Jan Kochanowski University will be nominated for the Rector's Award "Prodomus" in each discipline. An award for the best poster presentation is also planned for Jan Kochanowski University students.

Doctoral students and students of bachelor's, master's and uniform master's studies from other universities can present their own scientific interests, but do not take part in the Prodomus Award Contest.

The electronic application form should be sent by <u>15th October 2020</u> to the email address <u>ursd@ujk.edu.pl</u>. The abstracts will be published in the book of abstracts of the UJK PhD Students' Forum.
