

TRANSLATION. THE POLISH VERSION IS THE BINDING DOCUMENT

Regulations of the competition for the Rector's PRODOMUS Award for participants of the 7th edition of the Doctoral Forum of Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce

§ 1

1. The competition for the Rector's PRODOMUS Award for participants of the 1) the competition, is intended for doctoral students of the Doctoral School of Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce participating in the Forum.
2. The competition involves presenting a presentation on current research or projects during the Doctoral Forum of Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce, hereinafter referred to as the Forum.
3. All costs associated with preparing the presentation for the competition are borne by the participant.
4. The aim of the competition is to select the best presentations delivered at the Forum in various disciplines:
 - 1) history,
 - 2) linguistics,
 - 3) literary studies,
 - 4) medical sciences,
 - 5) health sciences,
 - 6) pedagogy,
 - 7) social communication and media studies,
 - 8) management and quality sciences,
 - 9) political and administrative sciences,
 - 10) legal sciences,
 - 11) security studies,
 - 12) biological sciences,
 - 13) chemical sciences,
 - 14) physical sciences,
 - 15) earth and environmental sciences,
 - 16) musical arts,
 - 17) visual arts and art conservation.

§2

- 1) Presentations submitted by Forum participants are eligible for the competition. Participants submit a paper form of a statement regarding the processing of personal data, which constitutes Annex No. 1 to these regulations.
- 2) The evaluation of presentations presented during the Forum is carried out jointly by members of the Competition Committee in individual disciplines, consisting of a minimum of three persons – academic teachers, at least two of whom hold a doctoral degree and represent the respective discipline.
- 3) Members of the Committee referred to in point 2 are appointed by the Director of the Doctoral School in consultation with the Directors of the Institutes responsible for the disciplines.
- 4) The Committee members referred to in point 2 jointly evaluate the presentations by entering the number of awarded points on the evaluation form. Then, a ranking list is created. The evaluation form template constitutes Annex No. 2 to these regulations.
- 5) The Committees referred to in point 2 evaluate based on the following criteria:
 - 1) scientific originality of the presented work 0-20 points,
 - 2) application of scientific apparatus 0-20 points.
- 6) The place on the ranking list is determined by the number of points obtained.
- 7) After evaluating the presentations, the ranking lists are passed to the Scientific Committee of the Doctoral Forum of Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce, which selects the competition winners in individual disciplines.
- 8) The competition winner receives a certificate of recognition and a book prize worth no more than 200 PLN.

§3

- 1) The announcement of the competition results takes place on the last day of the Doctoral Forum of Jan Kochanowski University in Kielce.
- 2) Competition winners will be notified by email about the award ceremony.
- 3) The prizes in the Prodomus competition are funded from the funds of the NAWA STER project – internationalization of doctoral schools.
